*Dear Julia Ruskin,*

*This past week at Camp Sunshine has been such an amazing gift for our family. We began coming to camp in 2007 when our son Henry was 20 months old. He had recently been diagnosed with retinoblasma, a rare eye cancer, and had his left eye removed. Back in 2007, camp was a place for my husband and I to meet other families whose children had also lost an eye, who had to learn the world of ophthalmologists and exams under anesthesia; it was a respite from caring for toddler twins, it was a blessing. But now, seven years later it is all that and so much more- Henry and his twin brother Jack are able to fully experience all that camp has to offer in a way they couldn't when they were babies. They have kayaked and swam, done arts and crafts, performed in a talent show, made new friends, and most importantly fit in utterly and completely. Henry has been able to meet other children who are "just like him," children who know what it means to have lost an eye, wear a prosthetic, need protective glasses, children who have survived retinoblasma, just like him. Camp Sunshine is a truly magical place and we thank you from the bottom of our hearts for your generosity that allowed us to have this week. It truly means the world for us.*
